



IV THERAPY AFTER CARE

Immediately after the treatments, you should feel better than before overall.

Potential complications can include irritation or bleeding from the IV site, nausea, or low blood sugar. If you are diabetic, your blood sugar readings may be inaccurate for the next 3-6 hours.

Should you feel ill with a fever over 101.5 or the area where the IV was placed becomes red, please call the office, or go to the emergency room.

You may otherwise go about your day regularly. There are no other precautions to take.
